

## SUMMARY REPORT #1 (SCENARIO 3)

**Date: week 7**  
**Scenario 03**

- The first confirmed case of Ebola virus disease (EVD) was reported on day 1 in Nimba.
- A total number of 161 EVD confirmed and probable cases was reported till week 7 across Liberia, most of the cases were reported in Nimba. The rest of the cases were reported in nearby counties to the west of Nimba.
- A total number of 82 deaths were reported till week 7 across Liberia, the majority of which were in Nimba. The rest of cases are reported in nearby counties to the west of Nimba.
- A total number of 12 health care workers(HCW) infections were reported, among which 11 in the county Nimba, 1 in Bong, 4 of them are among the fatalities counted up to week 7.
- Traditional burial practices were observed among all communities. These practices involve washing/touching/kissing the bodies during ceremony. The practices are confirmed to contribute to the spreading of EVD. No effective safe burial protocol has been enforced till week 7.
- No contact tracing cases were followed until week 7.
- No Ebola Treatment Unit (ETU) is operational at week 7. No plans for opening ETUs in near future.
