

SUMMARY REPORT #2 (SCENARIO 3)

Date: week 14
Scenario 03

- A total number of 391 EVD confirmed and probable cases was reported from week 7 till week 14 across Liberia, more than half of the cases were reported in Nimba. The rest of the cases were reported in 8 other counties of Liberia.
- A total number of 295 deaths were reported from week 7 till week 14 across Liberia, about half of which were in Nimba.
- A total number of 26 health care workers(HCW) infections were reported, among which 12 in the county Nimba, 2 in Grand Gedeh, 12 in Bong. 18 new deaths of HCWs are reported among the fatalities counted from week 7 up to week 14.
- Traditional burial practices were observed among all communities. These practices involve washing/touching/kissing the bodies during ceremony. The practices are confirmed to contribute to the spreading of EVD. No effective safe burial protocol has been enforced from week 7 till week 14.
- No contact tracing cases were followed from week 7 till week 14.
- No Ebola Treatment Unit (ETU) is operational as of week 14. However, there will be approximately 100 to 150 beds opening from week 14 onward in two or more ETU facilities around the country.
