

## SUMMARY REPORT #5 (SCENARIO 3)

**Date: week 32**  
**Scenario 03**

- A total of 1002 EVD confirmed and probable cases were reported from week 25 till week 32 across Liberia. 14 of the counties have new cases reported during this time period.
- A total number of 1062 deaths were reported from week 25 till week 32 across Liberia.
- There is consistent evidence from the field that the epidemic is steadily decreasing at least in the last 4 weeks, in most of the counties. ETUs occupancy is however in the lower 80% for most of the facilities.
- A total number of 54 health care workers(HCW) infections were reported, among which 1 in the county Nimba, 4 in Grand Gedeh, 1 in Bomi, 2 in Lofa, 35 in Montserrado, 9 in Grand Cape Mount, 2 in Bong. 55 new deaths of HCWs are reported among the fatalities counted from week 20 up to week 25.
- An effective safe burial protocol was being enforced from week 25 till week 32. It is estimated that 9 out of ten burials are safe and dignified.
- A total number of 6198 individuals has been contact traced from week 25 till week 32.
- All ETUs opened so far remain in operation. No ETUs has opened between week 25 and week 32. There are no plans for opening more ETUs in the near future.
