

## SUMMARY REPORT #1 (SCENARIO 4)

**Date: week 16**  
**Scenario 04**

- The first confirmed case of Ebola virus disease (EVD) was reported on day 1 in Montserrado.
- A total number of 298 EVD confirmed and probable cases was reported till week 16 across Liberia, more than half of the cases were reported in Montserrado. The rest of the cases were reported in nearby counties in the northwest of Liberia.
- A total number of 158 deaths were reported till week 16 across Liberia, the majority of which were in Montserrado. The rest of cases are reported in nearby counties in the northwest of Liberia.
- A total number of 6 health care workers(HCW) infections were reported, among which 4 in the county Montserrado, 1 in Margibi, 1 in Bong, 3 of them are among the fatalities counted up to week 16.
- Traditional burial practices were observed among all communities. These practices involve washing/touching/kissing the bodies during ceremony. The practices are confirmed to contribute to the spreading of EVD. No effective safe burial protocol has been enforced till week 16.
- No contact tracing cases were followed until week 16.
- No Ebola Treatment Unit (ETU) is operational at week 16. There will be approximately 20 to 50 beds opening from week 16 onward in one or more ETU facilities around the country
