

SUMMARY REPORT #5 (SCENARIO 4)

Date: week 35
Scenario 04

- A total of 1070 EVD confirmed and probable cases were reported from week 32 till week 35 across Liberia, about one third of the cases were reported in Montserrado. The rest of the cases were reported in 11 other counties across Liberia.
- There is no sign of a consistent slowing down of the epidemic. Most of the counties register an increasing or almost steady number of new cases. ETs occupancy is close to maximum capacity in most of the facilities.
- A total number of 710 deaths were reported from week 32 till week 35 across Liberia, about one third of which were in Montserrado.
- A total number of 32 health care workers (HCW) infections were reported from week 32 to week 35, among which 8 in the county Montserrado, 16 in Grand Gedeh, 1 in Margibi, 1 in Nimba, 1 in Bomi, 3 in Lofa, 2 in Grand Cape Mount. 31 new HCW deaths were reported among the fatalities counted from week 32 to week 35.
- An effective safe burial protocol was enforced from week 32 till week 35. It is estimated that 90% of the burial are safe and dignified.
- A total of 4139 of individuals has been contact traced from week 32 to week 35.
- All ETUs opened previously stay in operation with full capacity. New ETUs have opened from week 32 and afterward, providing approximately additional 100 to 150 beds and 100 to 150 HCWs.
